### WHAT'S NEW

The **Red Pepper House** is a new boutique beach hotel on Lamu Island, close to Lamu Town. It consists of five spacious Nyumbas (the Swahili name for home), with thatched roofs. Guests, who have their own butlers, can choose from activities like visiting the ruins of the city of Takwa, sunset dhow trips, snorkelling, deep sea fishing and massages.



Lamu offers some of Kenya's least developed coast, a tropical island with a distinctly exotic flavour, and white-sand beaches. Another reason to visit: Lamu is one of the oldest Swahili towns still in existence. Although staunchly Islamic, the Swahili culture emerged from a mixture of Arab and Bantu blood.

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
